BOOTH OPERATION TIMES

9:00 am to 5:00 pm, February 27, 2010

BOOTH SETUP ON FEBRUARY 27, 2010

The grounds at Hondo City Park #1 will open at 6:00 am

BOOTH BREAKDOWN

You may remove your booth after 5:00 pm on Saturday, February 27. It will be *your* responsibility to secure your exhibit in a manner in which you feel most comfortable.

PARKING FOR VENDORS

No vehicles will be allowed to park in the event area. Exhibitors will be allowed to off-load merchandise and then be directed to the Exhibitor parking.

DIRECTIONS TO HONDO CITY PARK #1

Hondo City Park #1 is located next to Fair Grounds and down the road from Hondo Golf Course.

From San Antonio Take Hwy. 90 west to Hondo (go through town to yellow flashing light which will be Castro Rd.) turn north on Castro Road. City Park #1 is on the opposite end of Castro Road.

From Uvalde Take Hwy. 90 east towards Hondo. As you enter Hondo go north on Castro Road (yellow flashing light). City Park # 1 is on the opposite end of Castro Road.

BOOTH INFORMATION:

- Handmade Western items preferred but not limited to. Merchandise must be described on the application. Submit photos of your products if possible. No carnival type vendors will be allowed.
- Exhibitor must provide own canopy, tables and chairs.
- A limited number of exhibitors will be selected.
- Electricity available on first-come basis. Please no generators.
- Gathering will not take place in rain or extreme cold. **NO REFUNDS**
- Setup will be on the ground – bring carpeting, rugs, etc. if needed.
- All booth fees are due with application and will be refunded if you are not selected to participate.

- You will receive your booth assignment at check-in.
- We will contact each booth applicant by phone/email regarding the status of your booth application. If you do not receive a phone call, please call (830) 426-1590.
- Exhibitors are responsible for the security of their own exhibit and clean up of all trash. A \$50 clean up fee will be charged if sites are not left clean.
